

M.S. Program in Seismology

Total credits for graduation: 28

Required Courses (7 credits)

Seismology (3 credits)

Seminar (I) (II) (III) (IV) (1 credit for each course)

Elective Courses (21 credits)

- Must include at least 12 credits for the courses open by M.S. and Ph.D. programs of the Institute of Seismology.
- Students can take courses offered other than the Institute of Seismology, but only from the College of Science or the College of Engineering. Before registering for these courses, students must fill out a consent form and have it signed by their advisor to be acknowledged as graduation credits.

Requirements for graduation

- Students shall complete the Academic Research Ethics Education Program and get the certificate before applying for the degree examination.
- Students must submit the “Thesis/Dissertation Title Inspection Form” before the end of the second semester after enrollment.
- Students must complete all the (required/selective) courses, at least 28 credits, prior to applying for the degree examination.

- Students must pass the degree examination and finish the master thesis to get the degree.
